**“2009” ADOPT-A-BABY PROGRAM
MONTH THREE**

THREE-MONTH DEVELOPING BABY: Your baby is quite active in the womb now—although his /her mother won't feel him/her for another couple of months. If his/her mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby squint, swallow, and move his/her tongue. He/she can make a tight fist if you could touch his/her palm. Touching the soles of the feet makes the toes curl down, and touching the eyelids makes the eye muscles clench. His/her liver is making bile, and the kidneys are secreting urine into the bladder.
